**STUDENT CONDUCT CONTRACT
UNO-INNSBRUCK INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL**

The UNO-Innsbruck International Summer School program has been offered since 1976, promoting academic excellence for over 40 years. It strives to provide a safe learning environment, one in which all students will grow and learn. If you choose to deviate from the program's rules, there will be consequences for such actions.

Failure to conform to UNO-Innsbruck program rules and regulations will be handled by a disciplinary committee consisting of UNO-Innsbruck faculty and staff. If the offense warrants expulsion from the program, you will be responsible for all expenses including return airfare.

Offenses that may result in dismissal from the program include:

- Use, possession, sale or furnishing of illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia
- Drunk and disorderly conduct
- Repeated abuse of alcohol
- Sexual misconduct and harassment
- Assault
- Making threats against another individual
- Theft
- Use of abusive language
- Failure to attend classes and other required program activities
- Failure to obey program rules & regulations, including housing regulations
- Any violation of any local law
