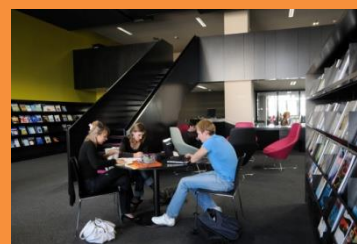

Registration	The administrative and educational enrolment will be done at the registrar's office of your department. Before leaving for France, do not forget to register with your home university, which will validate your year of study in France once you return.
Accomodations	As an exchange student, you have the right to ask for a room or a studio (depending on availability) in a university residence. For that purpose, you must have returned to us the booking form which has been sent to you once your file was accepted, before the deadline indicated on the document. This reservation is made for all the duration of your stay in France, from your date of arrival.
Budget	It is necessary to have an 800-euro average budget per month to live as a student in France.
